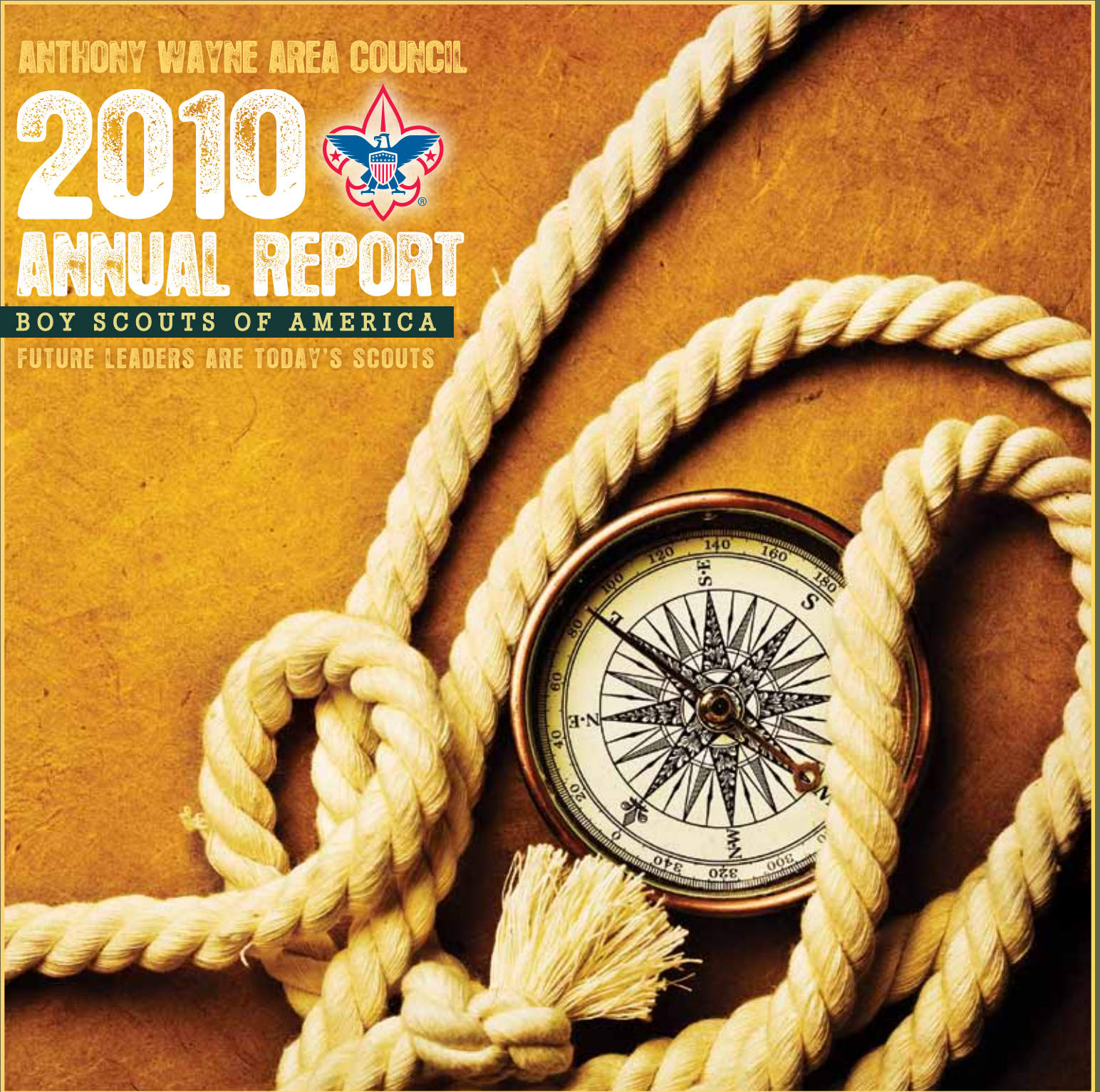

DEAR SCOUTING FRIEND,

Happy 100th Birthday to the Boy Scouts of America! Anthony Wayne Area Council celebrated this birthday by sending two troops to the National Scout Jamboree, we also participated as one of five councils nationally which were featured in "A Shining Light Across America" as part of the closing show of the National Jamboree.

We also earned the Centennial Quality Council award for the second year in a row and the second time in three years. Providing a high quality Scouting program to the youth of northeastern Indiana was clearly demonstrated as all six districts in the council achieved recognition as Centennial Quality Districts, a feat rarely equaled.

In 2010, we grew our traditional Scouting programs of Cub Scout Packs, Boy Scout Troops and Venturing Crews by 1%. The public support of Scouting may have been most evident in our fundraising efforts, as our direct contributions grew by 7%; and the popcorn sale grossed over \$1 million for the first time in ten years, returning over \$350,000 directly to Scouting units and youth to support unit Scouting activities.

Volunteers have always been the backbone the Anthony Wayne Area Council. Our 2,800 volunteers' dedication and passion for the Boy Scouts of America is evident in the quality and quantity of service that they give. Their commitment ensures our youth have the opportunity to learn self-reliance, leadership, values, teamwork, character and much more.

Over the past 100 years the Boy Scouts of America can be proud of the millions of hours of community service, the development of countless leaders in our communities, nation and world, and the teaching of values and character to the world. Still the greatest opportunity lies in front of us.

Now more than ever our youth need the lessons and skills that the Boy Scouts of America can teach them for their future. However, we can only assist those youth, who have the opportunity to participate in a Scouting program. We need your help in supporting and sharing the great programs of the Anthony Wayne Area Council and the Boy Scouts of America.

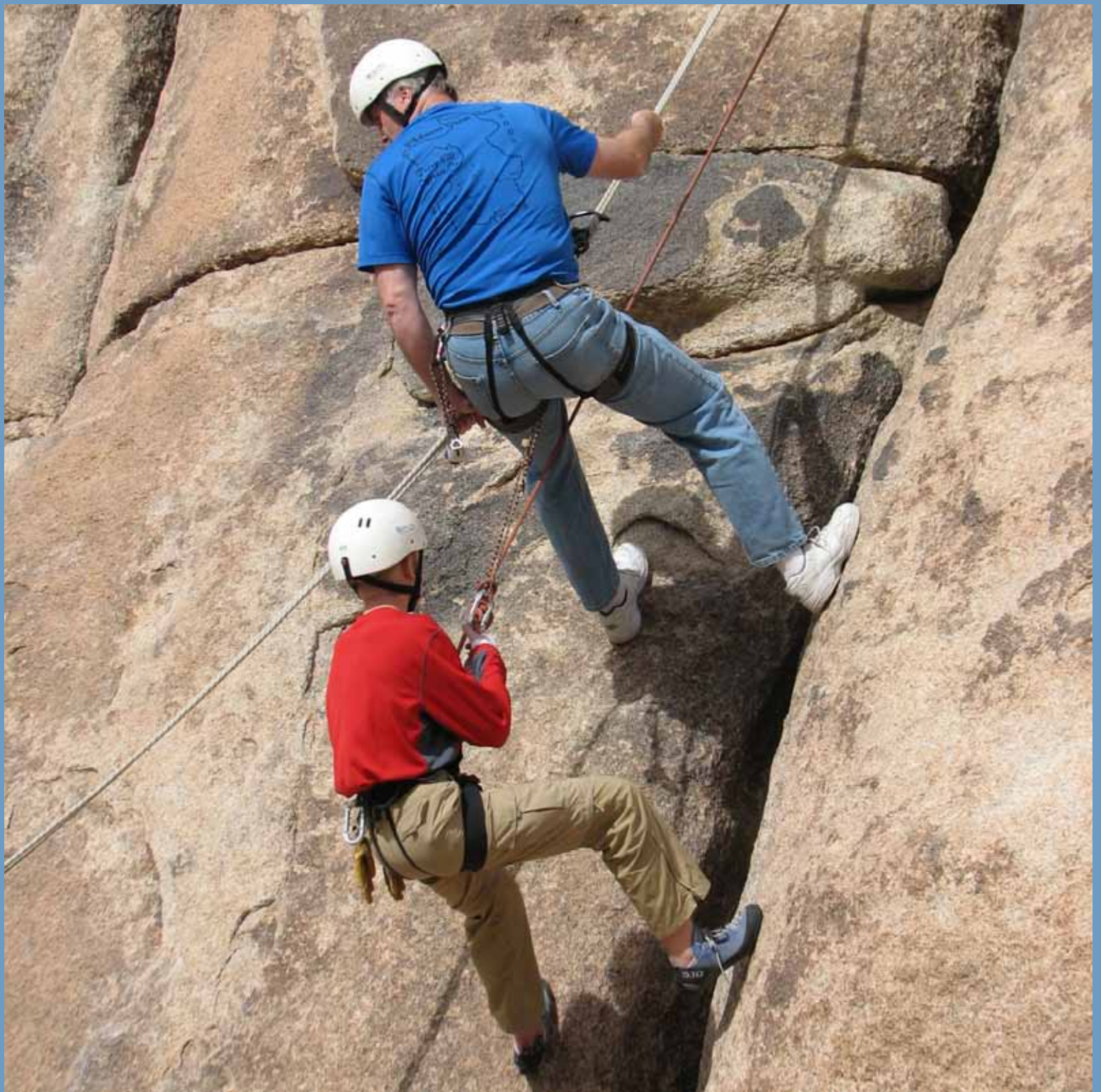
