**2013 National Scout Jamboree:**

Get ready! The 2013 National Scout Jamboree is coming and it is not your father's jamboree. We're talking seriously high adventure, with whitewater rafting, zip-lining, rappelling, mountain biking, hiking, and more – with 50,000 of your closest scout friends

**Anthony Wayne Area Council (AWAC) Contingent:**

Our council contingent will consist of 2 Boy Scout troops of 36 youth and 4 leaders each. That is a total of 72 youth and 8 leaders. Our contingent is also able to send a quarter of a Venture crew consisting of either 8 co-ed Venturers and 2 co-ed adults, or 9 Venturers and 1 adult (depending upon registration).

July 15-July 24, 2013

**Travel Dates for AWAC Contingent:**

July 14-July 24, 2013

**How to register:**

Registration is open on-line at [www.bsajamboree.org](http://www.bsajamboree.org).

Youth and parents/legal guardians need to complete the on-line registration process through the National web site. You will need parental/legal guardian consent to complete the entire registration process, including a picture of the youth applying to attend the jamboree. Then bring your paperwork and your \$100 down payment to the scout office. All applications MUST be completed on-line then approved by the AWAC National Jamboree Committee. Due to overwhelming demand, completing the application on-line and paying your \$100 down payment does not guarantee you a spot on the contingent. The contingent members will be notified of their selection by letter from AWAC. So please APPLY early. If you register and are not selected for the contingent, then your \$100 deposit will be refunded.

**Requirements to attend:**

Requirements for both youth and leaders to attend are posted on [www.bsaJamboree.org](http://www.bsaJamboree.org). Please read carefully, including the NEW physical fitness requirements.

**Adult Leaders:**

If you are interested in attending the jamboree as a leader, send an email now to [tmyers@InfiniaTech.com](mailto:tmyers@InfiniaTech.com) (Tom Myers) to arrange for an interview. We are conducting interviews and will select the leaders before the end of 2011. We need a total of 10 leaders (Boy Scout and Venturers) for our contingent. Contact Tom Myers for details on the leader fees.

**Travel Plans:**

We will travel directly to the Summit Bechtel Reserve from Fort Wayne leaving on Sunday night on July 14<sup>th</sup> and returning on July 24<sup>th</sup> in the evening also.

**Total Cost:**

\$1,300 for youth

Please note all costs are preliminary, and we hope to reduce the cost if possible through fundraising and fine tuning of our jamboree expenses.

**Payment Schedule:**

Application down payment of \$100 due with submitting application to AWAC office

\$400 due on or before February 29, 2012

\$400 due on or before July 31, 2012


\$400 due on or before December 1, 2012

Payment fee covers all transportation, meals, troop/crew equipment needed at jamboree site, insurance, personal day pack, personal duffle bag, jamboree hat, 2-AWAC jamboree T-Shirts, 2-National provided jamboree T-Shirts, AWAC training camp fees before jamboree, 2-AWAC unit numerals, 2-AWAC jamboree council strips, and AWAC contingent name plate.

**Refund Policy:**

If you sign up for the jamboree and then find that you cannot attend, you will receive a full refund from AWAC only if there is an alternate to take your place. In the event there is not an alternate to take your place, a partial refund will be made. This includes the fees you have paid to date, less any expenses related to contractual agreements made on your behalf.
